IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Gilman Water IL0750450

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the fourth quarter of 2024 we used a different address for our sampling of DBP and TTHM for and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What Should I Do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for [this contaminant/these contaminants], how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

Samples were taken to late in the quarter to be reported on time, the laboratory sent out the wrong bottles and had to be resent, then they were late getting reported to the EPA. See attached letter from laboratory.

What Happened? What Is Being done?

The house that had been used for the sample site for this testing no longer exists. We used the house next door without changing the sample site through the EPA, this is the cause of this violation
